Susan Allen, formerly Head of Special Collections at Honnold, has worked as Chief Librarian at the Getty Research Institute for the History of Art and the Humanities. She is currently living in Claremont and is Director of the California Rare Book School at UCLA. She will be speaking to us about "Your Old Books," a discussion about what makes a book rare, the condition of rare books, the difference between first editions and limited editions, and how to keep books in good condition.
