# Laurie Frankel: In Conversation

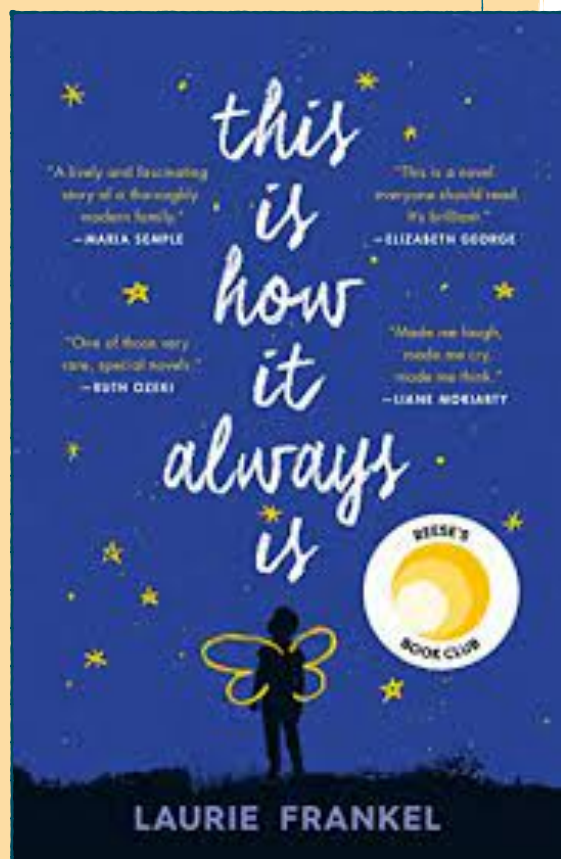

Laurie Frankel, the author of *This Is How It Always Is* and the newly-released and well-reviewed *Family Family* is coming to Claremont! She is the *New York Times* bestselling, award-winning author of five novels, which have been translated into more than 25 languages and been optioned for film and TV. A former college professor, Frankel

now writes full-time in Seattle, Washington, where she lives with her family.

In an interview she reminded us that “‘family’ and ‘normal’ are both wider and more complicated than we like to imagine.” And our *On the Same Page* book this year is definitely filled with the complications of family life.
