

# Books by Mail

Books By Mail is a free service of LA County Library. It is offered to residents that are homebound, persons in convalescent homes, and rural residents in the LA County Library service area. Eligible residents may request up to four books at a time. A library card is required. Please contact the library at 661.948.2410 or fill out the form below to request a card. A **valid ID** is required to get a library card. Staff will follow-up for this information. Shipping is free. Customers may designate a friend, family member, or library staff to choose books for them. Only books will be sent.

## To Order Books:

- Make your selection of titles from the [Library Catalog](#).
- Place a hold on the titles you are interested in, and make sure to select the **Books By Mail** pick up location.

## When you Receive Books:

- Save the shipping bag and mailing label.

## To Return Books:

- Please return the books within one month.
- Place the books in the reusable shipping bag.
- Reverse the mailing label.
- Place the shipping bag in the mail.
