An Afternoon with **Katie Orphan** author of ***Read Me, Los Angeles***

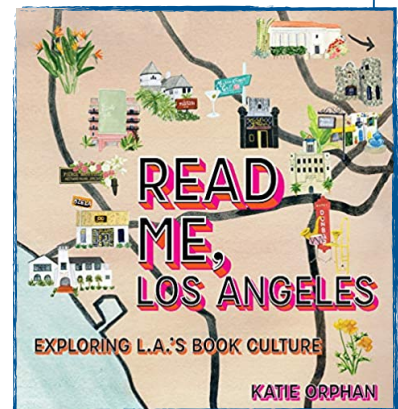

Author Katie Orphan was the long-time manager of The Last Bookstore in downtown Los Angeles, where she worked for a decade. She co-authored *The Last Bookstore's guide to downtown L.A.* She has been a longtime literary explorer. Katie is now the manager at Chevalier's Books in Los Angeles.

Read Me, Los Angeles is a colorful, lively, and informed celebration of all things bookish in L.A. past and present, including interviews with current L.A. writers and day trips in search of favorite fictional characters. You'll find author quotes galore as well as curated lists of the must-read L.A. books. Maps will show you where writers have lived and worked in the City of Angels. Katie provides insight into the city's book festivals, bookstores, publishers, literacy nonprofits, libraries, and so much more. This book is rich with photographs, book images, and vintage maps.



For the Love of Books is a yearly celebration of books, book groups, and anyone interested in building community through shared reading experiences. Each year the event organizers gather information from local book groups about what their members have read that year. The 2022 compendium containing lists from 39 Claremont-area groups will be distributed at the event and available electronically and on the *Friends of the Claremont Library* website after the event.
